The Edith B. Arnhold Memorial Scholarship

Edith B. Arnhold was the head librarian for nineteen years in the Cornell School District from 1962-1981 when she retired. She graduated from Westport High School in Kansas City, Missouri in 1934. Edith graduated Cum Laude from the University of Missouri-Kansas City in 1942 with a B.A. in History and Political Science. In 1962 she graduated Magna Cum Laude from the UW-Eau Claire with a B.S. in History and Secondary Education and a minor in Library Science, and went on to receive her Master's in Library Science from the UW-Madison in 1967 and became a member of Beta Phi Mu, the international honor society for Library Science graduates. Edith also taught several classes in Library Science as a guest instructor at the UW-Eau Claire. Education was extremely important to Edith, so her daughter Robin established this scholarship in her mother's name to help Cornell students continue their education.

The Edith B. Arnhold Memorial Scholarship will be at least \$1,000 and awarded annually to as many graduates as possible on the basis of academic achievement and financial need with the interest earned off of the endowed trust fund to Cornell High School seniors pursuing post-secondary education at a technical, two-year, or four-year college or university. This scholarship is non-renewable and will be paid directly to the higher education institution upon the recipients' successful completion of the first semester and proof of enrollment in the second semester for only the year after graduation from Cornell High School.

Application Submission:

- 1. Applications are to be submitted to the Cornell School District Superintendent before April 1st.
- 2. Applications may be submitted in a paper or electronic format.
- 3. Scholarship winners will be selected by the Superintendent and be announced at the Cornell Middle/High School Honors Banquet each year in May.

It will be your responsibility to submit your higher education 1st semester transcripts and 2nd semester schedule to the district office for scholarship distribution.
