Requirements

- Minimum GPA of 3.3
- Acceptance into accredited university, college, or technical institute
- Legible application, essay, and letter of reference submitted by deadline

Preference given to:

- Succession completion and/or near completion of three advanced science credits (Chemistry, Chemistry II, Advanced Biology, Human Anatomy & Physiology, and/or Field Ecology)
- Pursuit of career in sciences medical, nursing, pharmacy, dietician, physician assistant, nurse practitioner, dental hygienist, dentistry, occupational therapy, physical therapy, sports trainers, medical records, pathology, radiology, etc.
- Distinguished history of volunteer service

Selection will be made by the scholarship committee at Cornell High School.

An acrylic commemorative award will be presented at the senior awards banquet to the recipient.
