Pauline Johnston Jiskra and Gail Mittermeyer were 1964 Cornell High School graduates. Pauline and Gail were actively involved as Cornell students and positive role models in their communities as adults. This \$1000 scholarship is non-renewable and will be **paid directly** to the higher education institution upon the recipients' successful completion of the first semester.

Qualifying Applicants must be:

- 1. Cornell High School seniors eligible to earn their diploma by the end of the 2023-24 school year.
- 2. Planning on attending a technical, two-year, or four-year college/university during the fall semester of 2024.
- 3. Willing to complete and submit the scholarship application and letter of support by 4:00 pm on April 5, 2023.

Application Submission:

- 1. Applications, including the letter of support, are to be submitted to the Cornell High School office no later than 4:00 pm on Wednesday, April 5th, 2023.

Scholarship Recipients:

1. Scholarship winners will be selected by committee and announced at the 2024 Cornell Honors Banquet.

Applications Must Include:

- 1. Applicant's full name, address, school email address, and phone number.
- 2. Name of the anticipated post-secondary technical, two-year, or four-college/university.
- 3. Letter of support, non-family member, stating reasons why you would be a strong candidate to receive this scholarship.
- 4. An essay, **describing in great detail**, your desired area of study, anticipated career, and the courses and teachers that helped determine your decision.
